ABOUT YOURSELF:

How many hours per day will the foster dog be left alone?
What accommodations will you make to have the foster dog let out during the day for toileting and exercise?
The Buster Foundation requires that the foster dog be in the house, and crated at all times when unsupervised. Is this something you can commit to?
Are you willing to spend time each day to interact with your foster dog?
Foster dogs require socialization. This is important to the success of their adoption. Are you comfortable with taking your foster dog on regular walks?
What type of lifestyle changes would you need to make to accommodate a Buster Foundation foster dog?
Buster Foundation foster dogs should not be taken to work or school. Buster Foundation foster dogs are never to be left outdoors unattended – even in fenced yards. This is for the protection of the dog – bull breed dogs are masters of escape, often scaling 6 foot fences with apparent ease. In addition, bull breed dogs are especially vulnerable to theft – dogs are often taken from their own yards and used for fighting or breeding.
Can you commit to these and any specific instructions provided by The Buster Foundation regarding the care, training and well-being of a foster dog?
We require our foster dogs be inside your home during the night – can you commit to this?
Have you ever been convicted of animal cruelty, or ordered not to own an animal due to cruelty or neglect?

To never use physical punishment to correct your foster dog for bad behavior?

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU SIGN:

We recognize that fostering a dog is a full time commitment requiring responsibility and love. To ensure that our animals are placed in homes with people that are aware of this commitment, we ask that you re-read this application thoroughly, to ensure that you have answered truthfully and to the best of your ability. The intent of this application is to find the best possible match for placement of the pet, and to ensure the safety and health of our foster dogs. We thank you in advance for your interest in the foster care program.

PLEASE READ AND INITIAL <u>EACH</u> BEFORE SIGNING BELOW I am 21 years or older. I agree to a home inspection and meeting of all persons involved in the care of the dog to be fostered By signing, I give permission to The Buster Foundation to conduct a background check on myself, and understand that The Buster Foundation may request permission to conduct a background check from other persons who may be living in the same household or otherwise involved in the care of the foster dog. I understand and agree that I am not allowed to not give the foster dog to another person without the permission of The Buster Foundation. This includes leaving the animal in the care of another due to vacations or my extended absence from the home in which this dog has been placed for foster care. I agree that I will not give this dog to anyone or any other organization - but will return it to The Buster Foundation if I find myself unable to foster the dog for any reason. I agree that The Buster Foundation is the primary guardian for the dog I am fostering, and retains ownership of the foster dog at all times. Any decisions made in regard to the foster dog are first referred to The Buster Foundation for consideration and approval - this includes decisions relating to medical treatment of the foster dog. I understand and agree that The Buster Foundation will not be responsible for money spent, or bills incurred by foster caregivers for a foster dog that did not have the pre-approval of the Buster Foundation. All veterinarian care will go through The Buster Foundation. I understand that veterinarian expenses incurred without previous approval of The Buster Foundation is at the cost of the foster caregiver of the foster dog. The foster caregiver shall make no claim to The Buster Foundation for such expenses I agree that this animal will not be used for any illegal activities, nor will this animal be neglected or mistreated in any way.

I agree not to re-locate while serving as a foster caregiver without first notifying The Buster

Foundation. I agree not to re-locate to a municipality where the presence of a pit bull is illegal.

I agree to keep all of my personal information updated and current. I also understand that in the case of my relocation, the Buster Foundation reserves the right to re-inspect the home to ensure the safety of the fostered dog.
I agree that The Buster Foundation can, at any time, request permission to visit the foster home in order to insure the fostered dog continues to be housed in a safe and loving environment.
I agree that any prospective adopter that I may find for the dog I am fostering will be referred to The Buster Foundation to apply for adoption.
The Buster Foundation will determine which program/home the foster dog will be placed into. The Buster Foundation does not take responsibility for any negligence on the part of the foster caregiver for the foster dog and will not be responsible for bills incurred for such.
I agree to advise The Buster Foundation immediately of any unusual behavior exhibited by the fostered dog – including, but not limited to, changes in eating or elimination habits, trouble getting up and/or moving around, lethargy, apparent illness, and any sudden or troubling changes in temperament.
I understand that the foster caregiver is responsible for the care of any equipment and training supplies provided by The Buster Foundation, and should ensure that they are kept safe from chewing puppies, etc.
I agree to keep a collar and identification tag on my foster dog at all times. All foster dogs are provided with a buckle collar and leash. I understand any changes or "upgrades" is at the foster caregiver's expense. I understand and agree that all collars must be buckle collars in leather or nylon, and that at no time is the foster dog to wear snap collars, choke chains, pinch collars, etc.
I agree to notify The Buster Foundation IMMEDIATELY if the foster dog is lost or missing.
I agree to release the fostered dog to The Buster Foundation at anytime, with or without cause.
I agree to respond PROMPTLY to any contact by The Buster Foundation.

I acknowledge that the information contained in this form is true and correct to the best of my/our knowledge. I am aware that any false information is an automatic denial for fostering.
I understand that any misrepresentation of fact may result in the removal of the Buster Foundation foster dog, and cancellation of any involvement with The Buster Foundation.
I understand and accept full legal responsibility of the foster dog while in my care – relieving the Buster Foundation or representative of the Buster Foundation from any damages, injury to any persons or property or other liability incurred while the foster dog is in my possession.

THE BUSTER FOUNDATION COMMITMENT:

As a foster caregiver to one of the dogs from The Buster Foundation we guarantee that you will be treated fairly and justly, and as a respected and valuable part of the team.

The Buster Foundation will not discriminate against a person based on sex, race, religion or ethnicity.

The Buster Foundation will make every effort to fit the needs and requests of a foster caregiver to the best of our ability.

The Buster Foundation agrees that each foster dog will be examined by a veterinarian prior to placement. All health concerns will be properly addressed and the foster caregiver will be informed of any conditions prior to placement.

The Buster Foundation will not intentionally place a dangerous dog in a foster home. While we thoroughly assess the temperament and behavior of each foster dog, The Buster Foundation makes no guarantees of the continuing mental soundness of any foster dog.

Be advised that at any time while the foster caregiver is in possession of a Buster dog, if The Buster Foundation deems the foster dog to be non-adoptable due to aggression issues, serious illness or injury, or any other condition that may negatively affect the future adoption of the fostered dog, The Buster Foundation reserves the right to determine the appropriate action to be taken on behalf of the best interests of the foster dog, and the welfare and safety of the public which may include humane euthanasia by a licensed veterinarian.

Each foster dog will have a microchip traceable back to The Buster Foundation.

The Buster Foundation recognizes it is the foster caregiver who decides to foster a dog, and that the foster caregiver may decline any particular foster placement, with or without providing a reason.

The Buster Foundation will be responsible for any veterinarian bills concerning the foster dog's health. All health care provided while in the care of the foster home must be cleared through The Buster Foundation <u>prior</u> to any treatment being administered. Emergency veterinarian care is covered provided that the need for care was not a result of negligence or abuse on the foster caregiver's part.

The Buster Foundation will provide food and medications for the foster dogs. In some cases, foster caregivers may be reimbursed for approved brands of dog food up to \$20 per dog per month.

The Buster Foundation will provide each foster provider a crate or kennel, and food per availability to the foster provider for the care of the foster animal.

The Buster Foundation does not provide any financial compensation to foster care providers above the animals basic care expenses.

The Buster Foundation has the right to remove any animal from a foster placement at any time when neglect or abuse is suspected or witnessed. Foster providers who engage in this type of behavior will be terminated and reported to the authorities for animal abuse.

The Buster Foundation reserves the right to remove the animal from the premises of the foster caregiver for any reason. Failure to relinquish the dog to The Buster Foundation will result in immediate termination of foster caregiver rights. In addition, failure to relinquish a fostered dog will result in an immediate report being filed with the authorities for stolen property.

The Buster Foundation agrees to be available to foster caregivers throughout their commitment for training, consult, boarding and questions. The Buster Foundation encourages foster caregivers to contact us with any concerns or questions about the health, behavior or training of their fostered dogs.
